Market Rules

- 1. Market Setup time.**
There is strictly no site setup allowed before 7:30am.
This is due to Council noise regulations.
- 2. Market trading hours.**
Trading hours are 8:30a.m. to 12:30pm.
Stallholders must cease trading at 12:30pm and pack up their wares.
- 3. Rubbish**
Stallholders are responsible for the removal of their own rubbish.
The Stallholder must stop trading at the market closing time as determined by Rotary and after packing up, leave the site clean and remove any unsold or unwanted items.
- 4. Stallholders must be on site by 8:45a.m.**
If you are late your pre-booked site may be allocated to a casual stallholder after that time.
Any stallholder, who has pre-booked a site and fails to attend without notifying the Supervisor of the cancellation, may lose the right to occupy their former site.
- 5. Bookings.**
Bookings can be made by telephoning the Market Bookings number (above) between 9:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday.
Bookings will not be accepted after 5:00pm Friday.
Sites are generally available on the day of the Market
- 6. Cancellations.**
Cancellations may be made by telephone to the Market Booking number (above) 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
Where possible, requests for absences by stallholders for holidays, etc. will be accommodated.
- 7. Vehicle Access.**
Entry and Exit for stallholders' vehicles is via the lane off Wilson Street only.
Vehicles staying on site must stay until the close of the market at 12:30pm.
Vehicles will not be allowed into the site to pack up until after 12:30pm.
Stallholders with large or high vehicles must check in with the Market Management before entering the market site.
- 8. Cost of Sites.**
We reserve the right to revise site costs at any time.
Stallholders are required to have the required funds available for collection at 10:00am.
Please assist Market Management by having the correct amount available.
- 9. Directions and Requests from Market Management**
It is a condition of entry that stallholders must comply with the requests and directions of the market management and any by-law, regulation, act or statute as enacted by Local, State, or Federal Governments. Any stallholder who refuses to comply with the above may be ejected or caused to be ejected from the site and/or may be refused a site in the future.

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10. **Food Preparation**
Any stallholder selling or preparing food must ensure that all health regulations are complied with and that the food is stored prepared and cooked in a hygienic manner. Smoking is not permitted on any food stall, undercover or outside.
11. **Trestles**
Stallholders may rent trestles from Market Management for use on their stall at a cost of \$5.00 per table plus a \$2.00 deposit. Trestles must be returned by 1:00pm.
12. **Indemnity**
The stallholder hereby indemnifies the Rotary Club of Albury North Inc. and the Rotary Club of Belvoir-Wodonga Inc. and Rotary International (Rotary), their members, servants and agents against all claims by or on behalf of any person or corporation in respect of any injury loss or damage arising out of or incidental to the occupation or use of space at the Community Market by the stallholder, his servants or agents.
Rotary accepts no liability for the loss or damage to any property, goods or articles of the stallholder howsoever such loss or damage may occur.
13. **Public Liability Insurance.**
Stall fees do not include Public Liability Insurance.
Stallholders operating rides or amusements must provide proof of Public Liability Insurance to Market Management before occupying their site.
14. **Admission**
The Stallholder acknowledges Rotary's right to refuse admission to the market of any stallholder or any other person or to eject or cause to be ejected any stallholder or any other person and his or her personal property without giving any reason for same.
15. **The Law**
The Stallholder is to comply with the law. Rotary shall not be responsible for the non-compliance by the stallholder with any Law, Regulation, Act or Statute.
16. **Firearms, etc**
The Stallholder is not to bring on site any firearms, ammunition, explosives or alcoholic liquor.
17. **Smoking**
Smoking is not permitted in any covered area of the market.
18. It is in the interests of both the stallholders and the Rotary Club of Albury North Inc and the Rotary Club of Belvoir-Wodonga Inc to provide a quality market and to encourage the community to support it.
